This project is located on the Middle Fork Ranger District of the Willamette National Forest. It proposes to thin ~17,000 acres of managed stands under 80 years of age to improve stand growth and vigor, and to produce a sustainable supply of forest projects, as well as sustainably manage the ~650 miles of roads with a combination of maintenance, storage and decommissioning.
