The City of Lowell will host a FREE city-wide clean-up to provide residents an opportunity to dispose of common household materials (see list below). The City reserves the right to refuse oversized loads, business waste or unacceptable materials. ***Proof of residency is required, and may be confirmed with a recent water, electric, cable or telephone utility bill.***

Acceptable Materials

- Plastics (i.e. lawn chairs, toys)
- Scrap Metal
- Furniture
- Bagged clothing
- Ink Cartridges (no cracks or leaks)
- Clean Appliances
- Tires (limit of 4, no larger than 17 in.)
- Small Electronics

Unacceptable Materials

- Household Garbage
- Construction Waste
- Fluorescent Lights
- Alkaline Batteries
- Household Chemicals
- Computers, Monitors, and TVs
- Yard Debris (acceptable at City Green Waste Collection Site)
