Old Business:

- **Master Park Plan** CA Cobb gave an update on items for the upcoming year, \$5,000 quote received for a Concept Plan to develop both parks. Discussion followed.

Wood chips for playground area have been ordered and will be delivered on April 21, 2016. CA is budgeting for bark mulch in the display areas in Rolling Rock Park. Discussion on what items need to be done during cleanup day. Discussion on BBQ following clean up: Maggie Osgood will provide potato salad, Karen Burford will provide the macaroni salad. The City will provide the remaining items.

New Business:

- **Horseshoe Pit** Tristan Woodhurst provided information on the making of a horseshoe pit. He needs to obtain permission from the Boy Scouts to proceed with this project for his Eagle Scout Badge. Discussion followed.
- Beautification Program Patricia Angelini suggested an idea for a Living Memorial/Anniversary Program, where a tree may be purchased to be planted in the parks or right-of-way, to help beautify the City. Discussion followed. A subcommittee was formed with Patricia Angelini, Warren Weathers and Karen Burford.

Other Business: CA reported that the old slides have been removed from Paul Fisher Park. Working on the budget for placement of hand dryers and soap dispensers in the restrooms, and researching what kind of cameras would work for Rolling Rock Park.
